- There is a minimum number of participants needed to run the workshop.
 - A participant must fully attend all hours of a workshop in order to receive a verification certificate of completion.
 - Continental breakfast, light lunch, coffee and snacks will be available on all three days. Dinner is provided on the 9th and 10th.
 - Participants staying on or near the farm are asked to arrive by 7 pm on the 8th.
 - All participants should be within easy driving distance of the workshop by the morning of the 9th. We are in a rural area and you'll need to watch directions carefully to end up where you need to be. Yes...your GPS should work just fine here.
